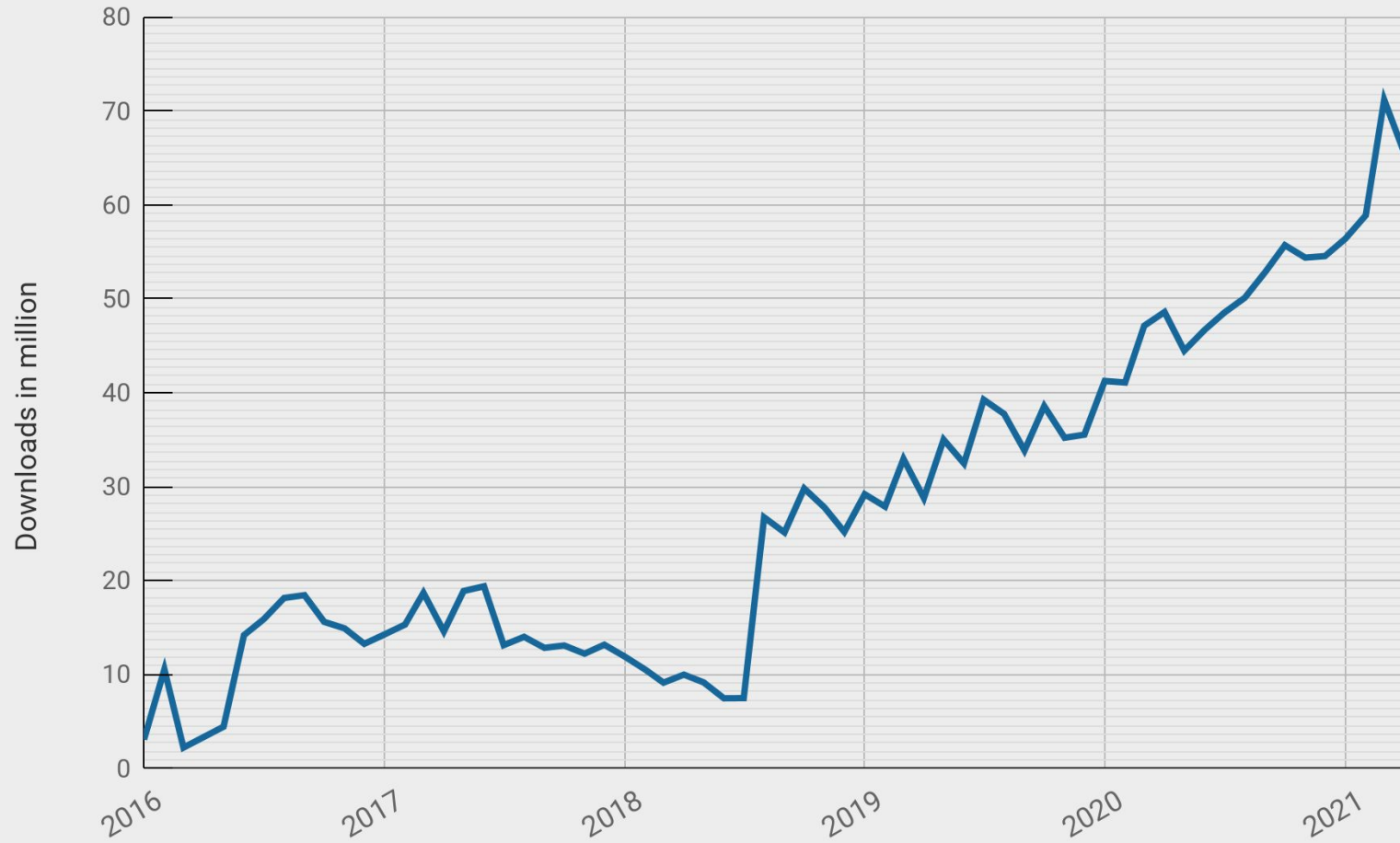


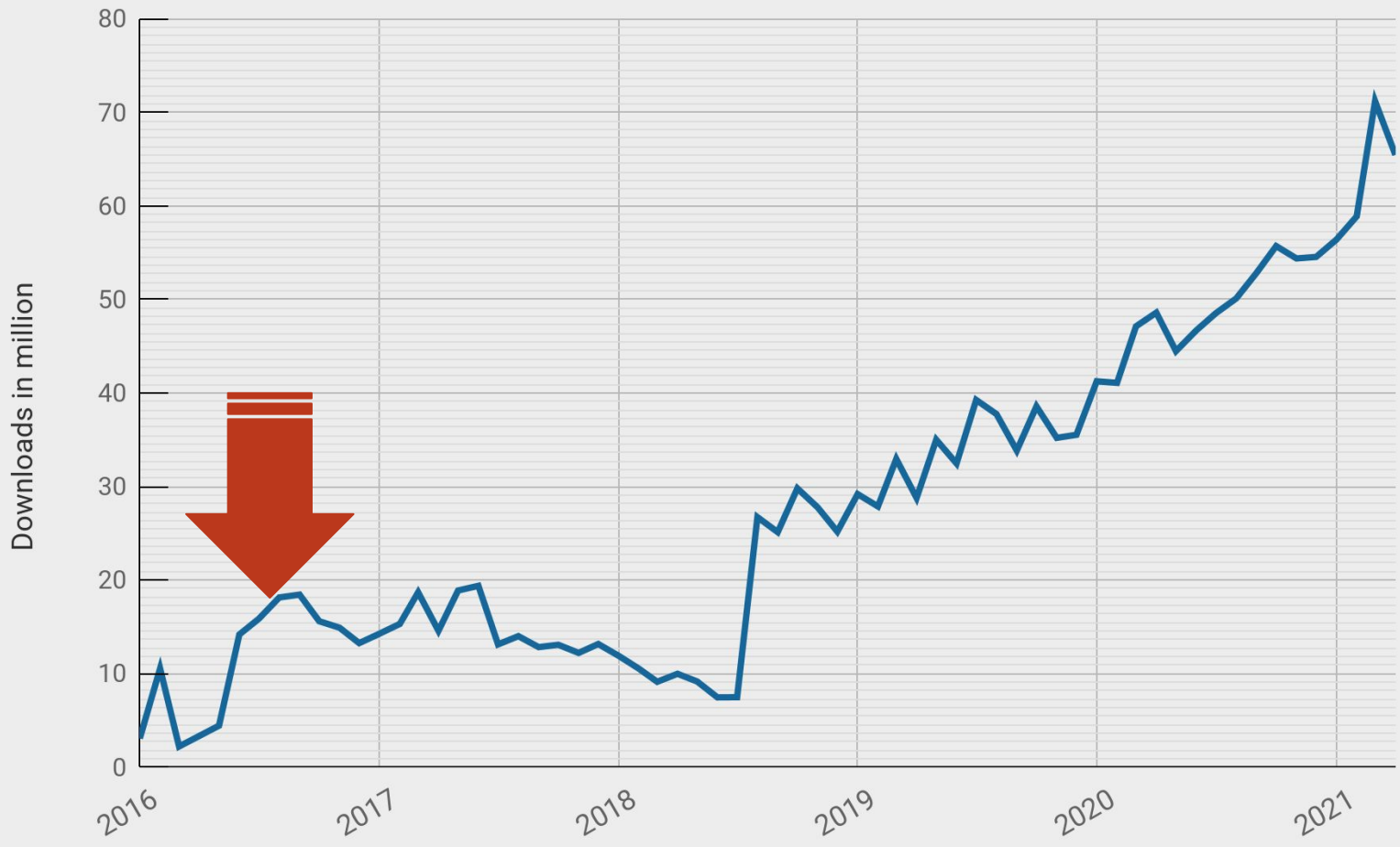

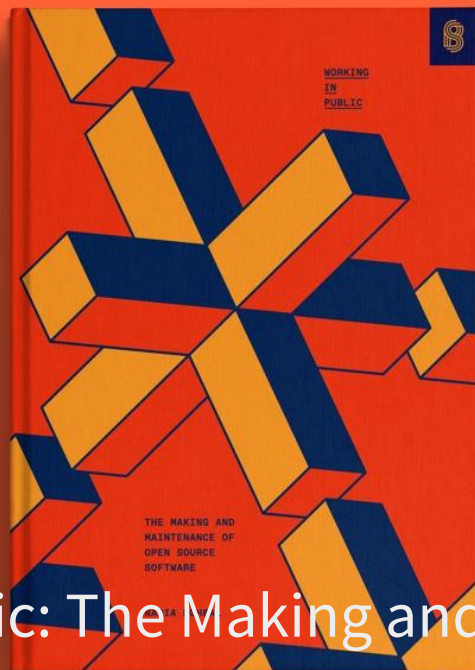

- Non-trivial functionality
- Documentation, if possible hosted on ReadTheDocs, bonus if using the Diátaxis Framework
- Tests that run automatically in GitHub Actions and development environment
- Adopts the Jazzband Code of Conduct and follows guidelines

past 5 years of Jazzband***

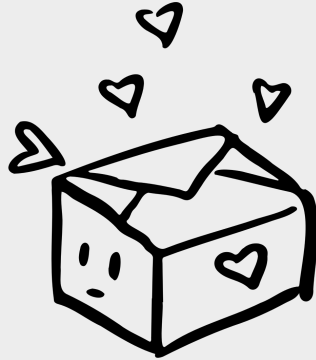
Members



- > 900 members currently
- 1350 unique members over the years
- 450 people have left again

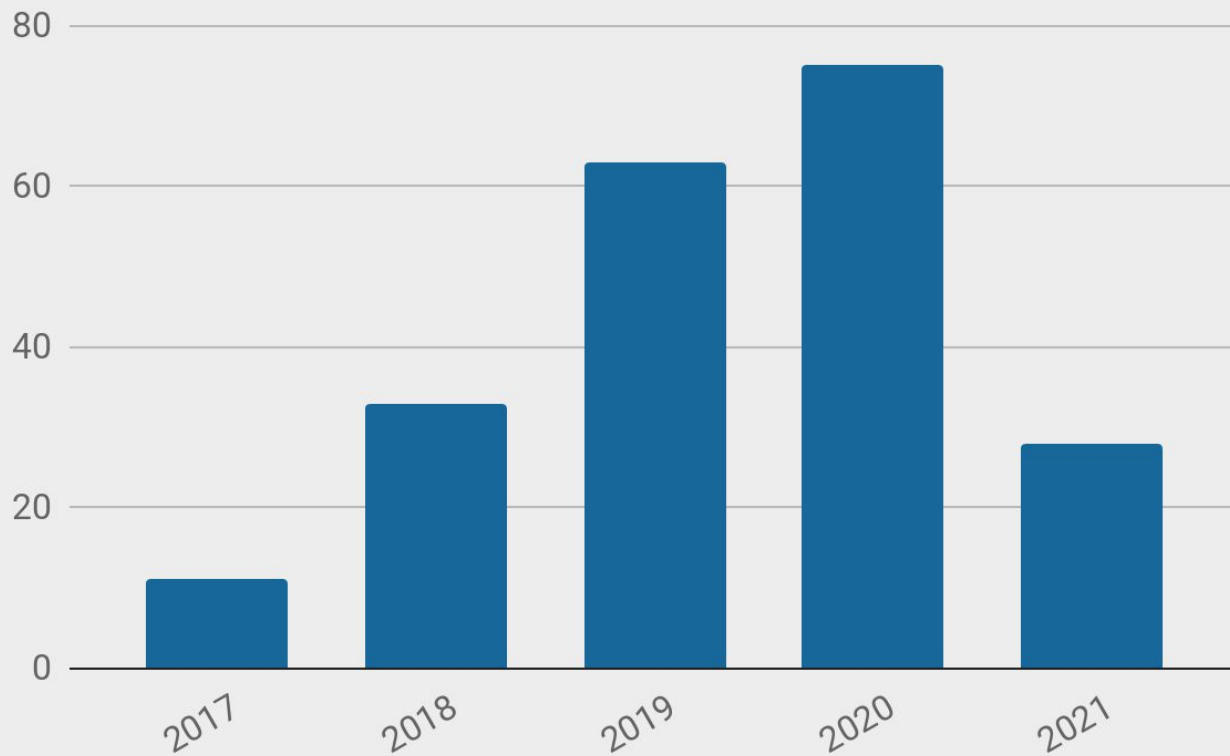
Projects

- 54 current projects
- 65 total projects
- 20 proposed projects



- 57 members are project leads, many in multiple projects
- 8 projects without lead

Releases per month



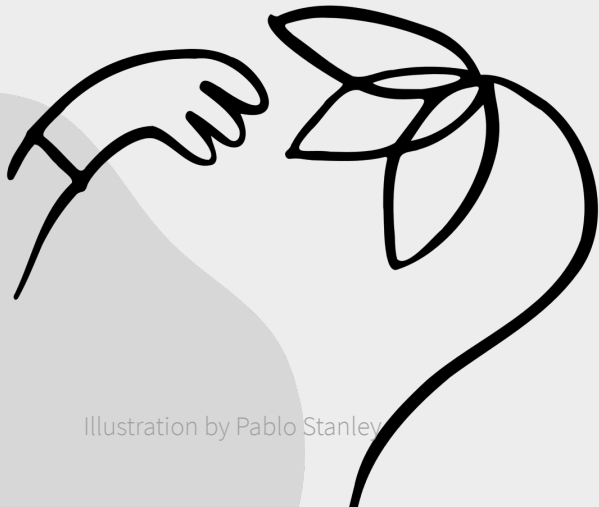
Activity

- 160 people pushed 6000 commits
- 4 🤖 pushed 145 commits
- 14500 people ★ Jazzband projects 22000 times



Issues

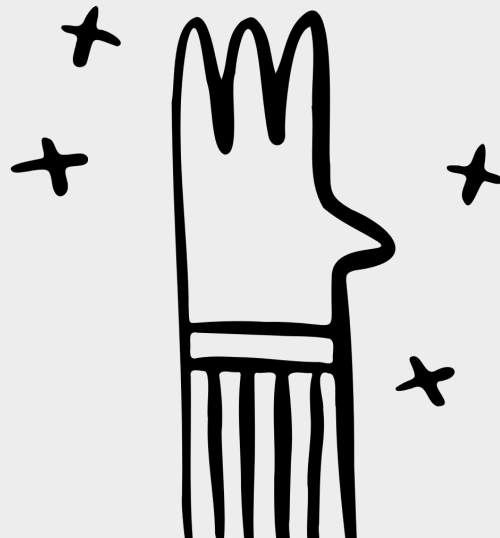
- 2000 people opened 3000 new issues
- 4000 people commented 17000 times
- 600 people closed 2500 issues



Pull request

- 1000 people created 3000 pull requests
- 300 people commented 3000 times
- 270 people closed 3500 pull requests

- 7 🤖 opened 600 pull requests
- 4 🤖 closed 200 pull requests again

But a sustainable solution doesn't exist without serious financial support.



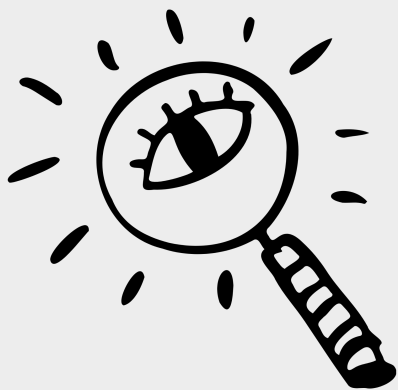

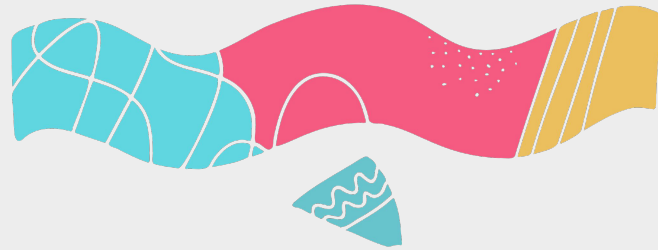
